



Plywood sheeting to be placed beneath trees and between trunks and wall when boundary wall being repaired to reduce compaction from site personnel, soil contamination from spilled concrete and damage during reconstruction.

Tree protection fencing to be retained in place. Any temporary removal should only be undertaken in compliance with the Tree Protection Strategy report and only when absolutely necessary to undertake wall repair works.

Tree protection fencing to be finally removed when landscape elements are being installed and the area is no longer accessible to construction related activities.
